- Approve November Minutes
 - Previous month's minutes approved at 6:39AM; Mrs. Sadiki moved to approve the minutes, Ms. Nelson seconded the motion.

3. General Discussion

- Introduction-New Assistant Principal
- Data Review
 - MAP Math Achievement Results Winter 2023
 - Our blues and greens are increasing across grades K-5.

- We have increased overall from 49th to 60th K-5; Fall to Winter Results
- Fall-all yellow; Winter-K,1, and 3 grow to green
- Growth Median By Grade Level
 - Blue in K, 1, 3
 - Green in 2
 - Yellow in 4. 5
- Median and Distribution
 - Kinder: increased from 54th to 70th
 - First: increased from 52nd to 69th
 - Second: increased 49th to 60th
 - Third: increased 50th to 70th
 - Fourth: increased 47th to 50th
 - Fifth: decreased 48th to 46th
- Solution To Improve Results: Skill Builder Club (Tutoring)
- MAP Reading Achievement Results Winter 2023
 - We have maintained from 55th to 56th K-5; Fall to Winter Results
 - This is positive considering teachers are learning a new curriculum (HMH) each day as they are teaching students each day.
 - Growth Median By Grade Level
 - Green in 3
 - Yellow in K, 1, 2, 4, 5
 - Maintained from Fall to Winter; minimal change
 - Median and Distribution
 - Kinder: increased from 50th to 54th
 - First: increased from 49th to 52nd
 - Second: increased from 48th to 58th
 - Third: decreased from 64th to 63rd
 - Fourth: increased from 57th to 58th
 - Fifth: decreased from 55th to 54th
- STAR Reading
 - We want students to read more challenging books.
 - Growth shown in grades 2, 3, and 4.
 - +7 points growth in grade 2 and -1 point loss in grade 5.
- Upcoming Student Assessments
 - We take the MAP assessment again in April or May.
 - We will take SBAC before MAP again.
 - EXACT PATH has a role in our achievement.
 - This is online tutoring paced according to MAP scores.
 - "Rainbow e" on Clever
 - Encourage students to do EXACT PATH at home.
 - Monday posting of EXACT PATH statistics continues.
